Explanatory notes—A student is a person who is enrolled in a school and active in a course of study other than preschool or TAFE courses. Students not present at school on the census date were included if they were expected to be absent for less than four continuous weeks (excluding school vacations) and were excluded if they had left the school or had been absent without explanation for four continuous weeks (excluding school vacations) prior to the census date. A full-time student is one who undertakes a workload equivalent to, or greater than that prescribed for a full-time student of that year level. This may vary between States and Territories and from year to year. A part-time student is one who undertakes a workload less than that specified as full-time.

The census date for the collection is the first Friday in August each year.

Explanatory notes, cont'd—The level of education is split into primary and secondary school education. Primary education typically commences at around age five and lasts for seven to eight years. It does not include sessional education such as preschool education. In NSW, Vic, Tas and the ACT, primary education may extend from Pre-year 1 to Year 6 (or equivalent). In SA and the NT it may extend from Pre-year 1 to Year 7 (or equivalent). In Qld and WA it may extend from Year 1 to Year 7 (or equivalent). Secondary education typically commences after completion of primary education, at around age 12, and lasts for five or six years. In NSW, Vic, Tas and the ACT, secondary education may extend from Year 7 to Year 12 (or equivalent). In Qld, SA, WA, and the NT it may extend from Year 8 to Year 12 (or equivalent). Part-time secondary figures vary considerably between States and Territories, as each education authority has different policy and organisational arrangements.

For the purposes of this collection, this includes principals, deputy principals and senior teachers mainly involved in administration.

Full-time equivalent (FTE) units are a measure of the total level of staff resources used. The FTE of a full-time staff member (i.e. employed full-time) and engaged solely on activities which fall within the scope of this collection) is equal to 1.0.

Explanatory notes, cont'd— Emergency and casual relief teaching staff employed on a casual basis are not included in this collection, as they replace permanent teaching staff absent for short periods of time. These permanent teaching staff are already counted in this collection.

Some States and Territories are not able to calculate FTE on a time-spent basis for all staff functions but use wages paid as a fraction of full-time rate, or a resource allocation based formula. Some also use a pro rata formula based on student or teacher numbers to estimate aggregate FTE for some categories of staff.

Explanatory notes— School staff are grouped according to functional categories. There are three categories for non-teaching staff based in schools. **Specialist support** staff are staff who perform functions that are of special benefit to students or teaching staff in the development of the school curriculum. **Administrative and aides** refers to administrative and clerical staff (including teacher aides and assistants whose main duties are generally of an administrative and clerical nature). **Building operations** staff are involved in the maintenance of buildings and grounds, etc. Also included are staff providing associated technical services and janitorial staff.

As a result of changed reporting methodology in 1995, non-government school staff who are not based at a particular school, but who are mainly active in schools, are now included in the published figures.

Full-time equivalent (FTE) units are a measure of the total level of staff resources used. The FTE of a full-time staff member (i.e. employed full-time) and engaged solely on activities which fall within the scope of this collection) is equal to 1.0.

Some States and Territories are not able to calculate FTE on a time-spent basis for all staff functions but use wages paid as a fraction of full-time rate, or a resource allocation based formula. Some also use a pro rata formula based on student or teacher numbers to estimate aggregate FTE for some categories of staff.

Explanatory notes— The 'students per non-teaching staff member' figures have been calculated by dividing the number of full-time students by the number of full-time equivalent (FTE) non-teaching staff members in the relevant category.

School staff are grouped according to functional categories. There are three categories for non-teaching staff based in schools. **Specialist support** staff are staff who perform functions that are of special benefit to students or teaching staff in the development of the school curriculum. **Administrative and aides** refers to administrative and clerical staff (including teacher aides and assistants whose main duties are generally of an administrative and clerical nature. **Building operations** staff are involved in the maintenance of buildings and grounds, etc. Also included are staff providing associated technical services and janitorial staff.

As a result of changed reporting methodology in 1995, non-government school staff who are not based at a particular school, but who are mainly active in schools, are now included in the published figures.

FTE units are a measure of the total level of staff resources used. The FTE of a full-time staff member (i.e. employed full-time) and engaged solely on activities which fall within the scope of this collection) is equal to 1.0.

Some States and Territories are not able to calculate FTE on a time-spent basis for all staff functions but use wages paid as a fraction of full-time rate, or a resource allocation based formula. Some also use a pro rata formula based on student or teacher numbers to estimate aggregate FTE for some categories of staff.

Explanatory notes—A school (other than a special school) must satisfy the following criteria: its major activity is the provision of full-time day primary or secondary education or the provision of primary or secondary distance education; and, it is headed by a principal (or equivalent) responsible for its internal operation; and, it is possible for students to enrol for a minimum of four continuous weeks, excluding breaks for school vacations.

The term 'school' includes schools in institutions and hospitals, mission schools and similar establishments. The term excludes preschools, kindergarten centres, pre-primary schools or pre-primary classes in or attached to non-special schools, senior technical and agricultural colleges, evening schools, continuation classes and institutions such as business or coaching colleges.

An Ancillary Education Establishment (AEE) is an establishment where the major activity is the provision of aspects of primary, secondary or special education to students supplementary to that provided by schools. AEE's include those education establishments in institutions and hospitals which do not have officially recognised student enrolments. These are not included as schools but the students and staff and staff data is included in relevant collections.

A special school provides special instruction for physically and/or mentally disabled or impaired students, or those with social problems. Students must exhibit one or more of the following characteristics before enrolment is allowed: mental or physical disability or impairment; slow learning ability; social or emotional problems; and/or in custody, on remand or in hospital.

Expenditure data used to derive per capita (cash basis) figures **includes**: expenditure on special schools; Commonwealth grants for education; expenditure on behalf of the Director-General of Education (or equivalent) by other State Government agencies; expenditure financed from Department of Employment, Training and Youth Affairs joint programs has been apportioned where possible between the government and non-government systems and only that portion expended on the government school system is included; and payments to staff in the form of allowances for accommodation.

Recurrent expenditure data used to derive per capita (accrual basis) figures **excludes**: expenditure of funds raised by schools, school councils and community organisations, sinking fund payments and interest on Commonwealth loans and expenditure on sessional pre-schools.

Recurrent expenditure data used to derive per capita (accrual basis) figures **includes**: salary and non-salary costs including superannuation, payroll tax workers compensation, operating expenses, grants and subsidies, capital charges (in Vic, Qld and ACT only) and depreciation.

This information has been compiled for the purpose of comparing recurrent expenditure data in primary and secondary education. Readers wishing to analyse this data for any other purpose are directed back to the tables and technical notes published annually in the *National report on schooling in Australia*.

Explanatory notes— To calculate the apparent retention rate, the total number of the full-time students in Year 12 is divided by the number of full-time students in the base year, which is Year 7 in NSW, Vic, Tas and the ACT in 1996 and Year 8 in Qld, SA, WA and the NT in 1997 (since those years represent the commencement of the secondary school system in the respective State or Territory). The resultant figure is converted to a percentage. Part-time students currently are excluded from apparent retention rates; the effect of this exclusion varies between States and Territories.

DEET, NT has advised that, commencing in 1995, students identified as secondary-aged in remote Aboriginal schools have been reclassified to the ungraded secondary category. The removal of these students from the calculation of apparent retention rates is partially responsible for the apparent increase from 1999.

Care should be exercised in the interpretation of apparent retention rates since a range of factors affecting calculation have not been taken into account. At the Australia level, these include students repeating a year of education, migration and other net changes to the school population. At lower levels of disaggregation, additional factors affecting the data, such as enrolment policies (which contribute to different age/grade structures between States and Territories), inter-sector transfer and interstate movements of students have not been taken into account. International comparisons are another area where structural differences must be taken into account.
